ESSAY GUIDELINES

- ◆ The Committee is interested in finding out more about you. For example, what you feel you have accomplished, what your goals are, what jobs or **volunteer work** you have done, or any civic activity/community involvement you might be proud of. What the Committee is looking for is information that speaks not only about your scholastic achievements, but also what you have done or would like to do in addition to your academic accomplishments/goals. Also please mention if you have intentions or interests in attending Fire Science courses.

- ◆ The only requirements for the essay are as follows:
 1. Essay must be typed, double spaced
 2. Length: Minimum – one page
Maximum – three pages
